

SUGGESTED WORDING For your Will or Codicil

Residuary Bequest

Suggested Wording

“I give to the Loughborough University Development Trust all (or a percentage of shares) of my residuary estate to be applied for:

1. the general purposes of Loughborough University

OR

2. The following purpose

The receipt of the person appearing to my executors or Trustees to be the authorised officer for the University shall be a full discharge to my executors and trustees who shall not thereafter be concerned as to the application of this gift.”

Pecuniary Bequest

Suggested Wording

“I give The Loughborough University Development Trust the sum of £
(Or such larger sum as my trustees calculate to have the same value at my death) as £ had at the date of my Will
(or Codicil) for:

1. the general purposes of Loughborough University

OR

2. The following purpose

The receipt of the person appearing to my executors or Trustees to be the authorised officer for the University shall be a full discharge to my executors and trustees who shall not thereafter be concerned as to the application of this gift.”

Reversionary Bequest

Suggested Wording

The wordings above should be adapted to suit your particular needs and wishes.

Specific Gifts

Suggested Wording

“I give Loughborough University Development Trust my (full description of item and location). I direct that the receipt of the person appearing to my Executors or Trustees to be the authorised officer for the time being of the University shall be a full discharge to my Executors and Trustees who shall thereafter be concerned to the application of my gift.”

If your gift to the University is for a specific purpose, we recommend that you speak to the Development and Alumni Relations Office to check that we will be able to fulfil your wishes. We also recommend that you contact your solicitor if you would like to make a gift part of your residuary estate.
